SUBJECT: Additional Cold Climate Jackets Order Form



Dear Sir/Madam,

On behalf of CFA and VFBV it is with great pleasure that we announce the bid for additional Cold Climate Jackets through this year's Volunteer Emergency Service Equipment Program has been successful.

It is envisaged that the allocated funding will cover up-to an additional 1,900 jackets State wide.

Exact numbers and allocations are unknown at this stage, but given the lead times between ordering and delivery, we need to have a rough idea around sizing. With limited funding available - it is generally accepted that the priority will be Class 1 and 2 due to the higher classes having increased access to Structural PPC which provides an additional layer of protection from the elements. On this basis, Class 1 brigades should plan for an additional two jackets, with remaining Brigades planning for one additional jacket. Consideration is also being given to allocating one jacket for each Group FCV/FOV's. This may change — and is subject to final funding and pricing.

As we continue to advocate for additional funding – the order forms are requesting Brigade's provide sizing preference and in what order. CFA will then follow your priority order when determining final delivery and allocation.

Brigades received 6 Cold Climate Jackets from previous years funding. Whilst Each District was requested to consult with Brigade's when placing previous orders, we are aware of instances where this did not occur. For this reason, VFBV has offered to run the ordering process to ensure Brigades and Groups have an opportunity to indicate sizing for the next batch.

The final decision on allocation and funding will be CFA's. As soon as we are aware of the final allocation, we will advise members. If you do not want any jackets, if you could please return the order form and tick the box that says "we do not want any jackets" this will allow them to be reallocated to other brigades that do require more, and allow consideration of additional jackets for Class 2 and 3 Brigades.

#### **PROCESS**

- Your brigade/group has the opportunity to receive additional CFA Cold Climate Jackets funded from this year's Volunteer Emergency Service Equipment Program. (VESEP).
- Exact numbers will not be known until final confirmation of funding and pricing, however as a guide Class 1 Brigades may receive two additional jackets, with other Brigades receiving one additional jacket in this round. Allowance has been made for one jacket to also be allocated to a Group FCV/FOV vehicle.
- Class 1 Brigades have been prioritised as these Brigades are unlikely to have a large number of members who have been issued with Structural PPC that already provides an additional layer of climate protection from the elements not provided by Bushfire PPC.
- VFBV will continue advocating for additional jackets and funding.
