For information, below are items of interest approved from the VFBV Competition and Rules Committee for the information of Coaches, Competitors and Judges and Officials for the 2022/23 Competition season.

a) 2023 State Championship Entries

Entries are now open for the 2023 State Championships and will close on <u>Sunday 19th February 2023</u>, entries will once again be collected electronically. Members who are responsible for entering their brigade should register for entry forms online: <u>tinyurl.com/2023-entry-eoi</u>

A link to the entry form will then be sent to the person responsible for completed the entry.

Brigades are reminded to complete the competitor information ASAP for all members especially those under the age of 18 to enable CFA to undertake the parent/guardian permission process prior to the Championships. The competitor information is also used by VFBV for the announcement of place getters and for the awarding of points in the Champion Competitor so should be as accurate as possible.

b) 2023 State Championship Judge and Official Nominations

Judge and Official nominations are now open and will close on Sunday 19th February 2023. To nominate as a judge or official for either or both of the 2023 State Championships, please complete the nomination form online: tinyurl.com/2023-urban-judge

Brigades are reminded of the requirement to nominate <u>two non-competing members</u> to act as a judge at each of the Championships. When a brigade has more than one Team competing, for every additional team, one additional <u>non-competing</u> member is required to be nominated as a judge or official. Failure to nominate the required number of judges may result in the brigade being disqualified from competing in a track event.

c) Skills Workshop – Judges and Officials, Coaches and Competitors

A new date has been set for the Judges and Officials, Coaches and Competitors workshop. The workshop will be held on Sunday 22nd January 2023 at the Bendigo Competition Track beginning at 9:30am.

The workshops will be conducted by experienced coaches, judges and officials with members interested in learning more about coaching or officiating at local competitions and State Championships encouraged to attend. Competitors interested in gaining new skills are also welcome to attend.

On the day there will also be a workshop on conducting safety checks on hoses and other competition equipment, members attending are encouraged to bring along their own equipment to learn how to check it if they would like to participate in this workshop.

d) 2023 State Championship Dates

The 2023 State Urban Junior Championship will be held on the weekend of 18 and 19 March 2023 in Mooroopna.

The 2023 State Urban Senior Championship will be held in conjunction with the State Rural Championships on the weekend of 25 and 26 March 2023 in Mooroopna.

2023 will also mark 150 years since the first Torchlight Procession was held in the streets of Melbourne.

e) Expression of Interest – Trophy Coordinator and Deputy for Urban Championships

The Committee are seeking Expressions of Interest from members who would be interested in taking on the role of Trophy Coordinator and Deputy Coordinator for the Urban State Championships.

The role entails sorting and organisation of station trophies, medallions and perpetual trophies on the Friday prior to the Urban Junior Championship, liaising with trophy sponsors and presenters across the weekend and ensuring trophies are ready for presentation at the completion of each event and for the closing ceremonies.

Competing brigades are reminded that borrowing rules for the female aggregate differ slightly compared to other events. Prior to the 2022 Competition season the Committee agreed that if a team does not have two female competitors to participate in the Female Aggregate they are able to form a combined team for the purposes of the Female events only with another Brigade with only one female competitor. Any Brigades that wish to undertake this option should contact the VFBV at championships@vfbv.com.au to register with permission to be provided from both brigades prior to any approval being given.
